

Call for Proposals The DADD Prism Monograph Series

The Publications Committee of the Division on Autism and Developmental Disabilities of the Council for Exceptional Children is calling for proposals for Volume 12, 13, and 14 in the acclaimed DADD *Prism* publication series. These short monographs, typically about 100 double-spaced pages in length, target topics of special interest to practitioners in the field of developmental disabilities.

Past volumes in the *Prism* series have focused on such issues as literacy skills, differentiated instruction, and instructional strategies for students with Autism Spectrum Disorders. For upcoming volumes in the series, to be published in 2017 and 2018, proposals pertaining to topics of interest to DADD members and the field are being solicited.

All royalties generated from sales are returned to the general revenue fund of the Division on Developmental Disabilities, helping to fund a variety of Division functions.

A proposal for a volume in the *Prism* series should include the following information:

- Names and contact information (phone, email, address) for each of the proposed authors;
- The title of proposed *Prism* volume, and the targeted DADD audience;
- A one-page overview of the proposed volume;
- A chapter by chapter outline of the proposed volume, including a proposed chapter title and a one paragraph summary for each chapter;
- A tentative timeline for the work.
